

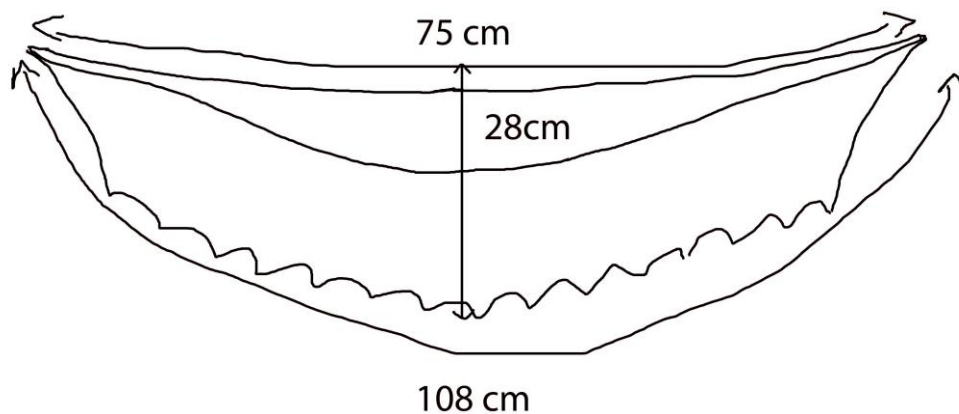
Niemeyer (Mini)**Niemeyer (Mini)****By Iris Alessi****Materials:**

1 1/2 skein of Golf – Lang Yarns – (185 meters / 202.5 yards – 100% cotton - 50g= 135 yards/123 meters)

Circular needles 5mm/ US 8 – 80cm / 32 inches - cable

Blocking pins

Gauge: 20 stitches x 22 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4x4 inches - without blocking

Final measures:

Niemeyer (Mini)

Keys:

	knit (k) right side / purl (p) wrong side
∧	knit 2 together (k2tog)
∧	knit three together (k3tog)
○	yarn over (yo)
∇	slip stitch as if to purl (s1)
∩	bind off



Notes:

The Niemeyer shawl is worked in shortened rows bottom up. The ending is divided in three charts. After finished, stitches are picked up to form the shawl body.

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The row 30 is not worked. Bind off the stitches and save the last one to use to construct the body.

Preparation for the shortened rows:

Pick up and knit 121 stitches on the side where you slip the stitches. You will have 122 stitches. One is the last stitches of the BO.

Shortened rows:

Row 1: k71 and turn

Row 2: p21 and turn

Row 3: 20m, ssk, k2 and turn

Row 4: p22, p2tog, p2, and turn

Row 5: k24, ssk, k2, and turn

Row 6: p26, p2tog, p2, and turn

Row 7: k28, ssk, k2, and turn

Row 8: p30, p2tog, p2, and turn

Row 9: k32, ssk, k2, and turn

Row 10: p34, p2tog, p2, and turn

Row 11: k36, ssk, k2, and turn

Row 12: p38, p2tog, p2, and turn

Row 13: k40, ssk, k2, and turn

Row 14: p42, p2tog, p2, and turn

Row 15: k44, ssk, k2, and turn

Row 16: p46, p2tog, p2, and turn

Row 17: k48, ssk, k2, and turn

Row 18: p50, p2tog, p2, and turn

Row 19: k52, ssk, k2, and turn

Row 20: p54, p2tog, p2, and turn

Row 21: k56, ssk, k2, and turn

Row 22: p58, p2tog, p2, and turn

Row 23: k60, ssk, k2, and turn

Row 24: p62, p2tog, p2, and turn

Row 25: k64, ssk, k2, and turn

Row 26: p66, p2tog, p2, and turn

Row 27: k68, ssk, k2, and turn

Row 28: p70, p2tog, p2, and turn

Row 29: k72, ms, 11m and turn

Row 30: p83, 2pjt, 10t, and turn

Row 31: k1, *yo, ssk*, repeat from *to* until rest one stitch in the needle, k1

Row 32: purl all the stitches

BO all the sts.

Finishing:

Block your shawl.
